Dear Infant Gabriel Gričiuite and/or carer,

This is your discharge letter which contains a summary of your stay in hospital.

You were admitted to Sky Cardiology ward on 16 Nov 2021 (6:26 PM) under the care of Dr. P Theocharis. The reason for your admission was: Ventricular tachycardia.

During your hospital stay, the following problems were addressed:

- Ventricular tachycardia [VT] [RVOT]
- Left ventricular fibroma (this was the main problem)

This is a medical summary of your admission:

Gabriel was admitted to Sky Ward following evidence of sustained multifocal VT on a Holter monitor in the community. He has a background of a large left ventricular fibroma.

Gabriel's atenolol was gradually incremented to 10mg BD. He was also commenced on mexilitine which was well tolerated. He is now on a full strength dose and a trough level was taken which was pending at discharge. There were no concerns re: sustained VT once established on these medicines.

Gabriel was discussed at MDT during his stay for a possible ICD insertion. The decision at MDT was rather for insertion of a Reveal device which was well tolerated. There were no periprocedural concerns.

Of note Gabriel was also found to be positive for human metapneumovirus on a respiratory viral panel during his stay. He remained stable from a respiratory point of view and there are no infective concerns on discharge.

He will be seen in Dr Theocharis' clinic in 2 weeks time, at which time his mexilitine level will be chased and a prescription for ongoing mexilitine will be provided.
